

The PIOB Standard-Setting Boards Nominations Committee issues Invitation for Applications for membership of the new Stakeholder Advisory Council

Madrid, July 11, 2023

The PIOB Standard-Setting Boards Nominations Committee (SSB NomCo) invites applications for membership of the Stakeholder Advisory Council (SAC), with a view to selecting candidates and recommending their appointment for PIOB approval in December 2023.

Applications are welcome by 30 September 2023 through [the Applications portal](#).

The SAC will begin working in early January 2024 as a new, prestigious global forum to provide strategic advice to the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board (IAASB) and the International Ethics Standards Board (IESBA). The SAC will replace the IESBA Consultative Advisory Group (IESBA CAG) and the IAASB Consultative Advisory Group (IAASB CAG) which complete their terms in late 2023.

The inaugural SAC Chair, Alan Johnson will bring extensive experience of engaging across multiple stakeholder communities in an international context. The SAC will provide strategic advice on the development by the IESBA and the IAASB in the public interest of high-quality audit, assurance, ethics and independence standards. The standards enhance the quality and consistency of services provided and, in turn, contribute to public trust and confidence in the global financial and non-financial reporting system.

The PIOB Nominations Committee strongly encourages applications which are diverse with respect to geography, gender and professional background. Our selection process will aim to deliver an appropriately balanced, multi-stakeholder set of recommendations for appointments to the PIOB by the end of the year for its approval."
